



North Halton Girls Hockey Association Dressing Room Guidelines

The North Halton Girls Hockey Association follows all Hockey Canada and OWHA Policies relating to Dressing Rooms (Supervision, cell phones, minimum attire, etc).

In addition to these policies, the following rules apply to all House League and Representative teams.

- 1) A minimum of two, properly screened AND registered females must be present in the dressing room, or immediately outside the dressing room, for all ages.
- 2) Males cannot enter the dressing room while players are changing/getting dressed for teams U9 and above.
- 3) Adults cannot enter the dressing room at any point unless they have been properly screened and registered for teams U9 and above.
- 4) Male coaches cannot be alone with players in the dressing room; there must always be a female coach, trainer, or den mom present.

*Exceptions will be made for the first couple of weeks of HL programming, while volunteers complete training/screening and rosters are finalized. Coaches can facilitate this process with the help of the HL Director/Executive.
